

**TOWN OF MARSHFIELD  
BOARD MEETING**

May 5, 2026

7:00 p.m.

Marshfield Town Hall

Town Officials present: Chairperson John Bord, Supervisors Ken Kraus and Joe Rappl, and Clerk Marlene J. Sippel. Members of the Public included Brad Witmer of Ramker & Associates, Inc., representing Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless and Marc Pasineau, Zoning Administrator.

John Bord called the meeting to order following the public hearings on applications by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a Special Use Permit.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Public notice was properly posted at the designated sites and it was published in the Fond du Lac Reporter.

The Board is acting on the Plan Commission's recommendation of the special use permit for a microwave dish and associated equipment to supply fiber to the site for Verizon's operation at N8306 Walnut Road, Mt. Calvary, WI.

Chairperson John Bord confirmed the following with board members:

All board members were present at both public hearing – Ken - Yes, Joe – Yes and John – Yes.

All board members agree that requirements of the zoning ordinance were met at both sites – Ken – Yes, Joe – Yes and John - Yes.

All board members heard all the evidence and agreed that each of the standards for the special use permit were met at both sites as did the Plan Commission – Ken – Yes, Joe – Yes and John – Yes.

Supervisor Joe Rappl asked Brad Witmer about the environmental impact of the microwave dish. After discussing the matter, Joe and Brad agreed that Joe will contact the professional engineer at Ramaker, Joshua M Opseth, directly to obtain an official answer.

Motion Kraus/Rappl to approve the special use permit that was recommended by the Plan Commission for Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless at N8306 Walnut Road, Mt. Calvary, WI. Motion carried, 3-0. It includes a contingency that prior damages must be repaired to adjacent landowners' property to their satisfaction before any further construction may start. Also, a board member must inspect site for damage prior to subcontractor leaving finished construction site.

There being no further business, motion Kraus/Rappl to adjourn at 7:13 p.m.
